Medical Review Committee Role

The Medical Review Committee; reviews care of ESRD patients in the Midwest Kidney Network region, oversees quality improvement and data management activities, and performs functions as required by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS).

Medical Review Committee Responsibilities

Within the scope of the CMS contract; develops and implements activities to improve the quality of care provided to ESRD patients receiving care in the Midwest Kidney Network region.

- Observes the Midwest Kidney confidentiality policies and signs confidentiality statements.
- Supervises response to patient grievances.
- Observes Midwest Kidney Network/CMS data release policies.
- Responds in a timely manner to Medical Review Committee business.
- Attends four meetings per year (usually three conference calls and one in-person meeting) and participates in other meetings (usually webinars) as needed for specific issues.
- Participates in Midwest Kidney Network's Annual Council Meeting.
- Observes Midwest Kidney Network bylaws and due process.
- Supports Midwest Kidney Network's mission, goals, and objectives.

Additional Specific Responsibilities by Discipline

- 1. Clinician members participate in the medical review process including review of patient-specific medical records, facility-specific profiles, and facility policies/procedures. Usually reviews are performed off-site, but occasionally on-site reviews are necessary.
- 2. Social worker member assists with patient concerns as needed.
- 3. Consumer members observe the review process and offers perspective on consumer issues.

Organizational Relationships

- 1. Reports to the Board of Directors.
- 2. Represents the Network Council.
- 3. Receives input from CMS, other Committees, and other related agencies.
- 4. Staffed by Quality Improvement staff and the Executive Director
