

IMMUNIZATION IMPACT AWARD 2025-2026

As part of National Immunization Awareness Month in August, the Midwest Kidney Network is eagerly kicking off Immunization Impact Awards. This two-part recognition program and poster contest is designed to reinvigorate immunization campaigns in dialysis clinics while providing coaching and resources, mixed with enthusiasm and friendly competition to help achieve immunization goals to impact patient outcomes. We invite all dialysis facilities to participate in either or both parts of the program, give it a shot!



IMMUNIZATION IMPACT AWARD - TIERED RECOGNITION PROGRAM

MKN will recognize **Immunization Impact Award** dialysis facilities in the Network based on the following tiers:



Gold: Utilized MKN strategies and resources, and met/exceeded **both** patient influenza and pneumococcal vaccination goals, defined as achieving 80% vaccination rates in both patient influenza & pneumococcal, or demonstrating a 20% improvement in each of the rates



Silver: Utilized MKN strategies and resources, and met/exceeded *either* the patient influenza *or* pneumococcal vaccination goals (same defining criteria as above)



Bronze: Utilized MKN strategies and resources, *and* engaged in MKN coaching, but did not meet either of the vaccination goals

- To earn a tiered recognition, complete an attestation indicating which Network resources were utilized (see page 2) prior to December 31, 2025.
- On February 1, 2026, the Network will monitor and use influenza and pneumococcal vaccination rates from the EQRS dashboards to determine if goals are met. Follow along on the dashboards to monitor your progress in real time!
- Certificates of achievement will be awarded in February 2026.

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NETWORK IMMUNIZATION STRATEGIES AND RESOURCES

To earn tiered recognition, utilize two or more strategies and/or resources listed below and complete the <u>self-attestation</u> **prior to December 31, 2025.**

Strategy : Complete an immunization reconciliation between your electronic health
record, EQRS, and the state vaccination registry. (Note, the Network utilizes EQRS rates
for the project).
Strategy: Utilize motivational interviewing techniques when discussing vaccinations with
patients. (see vaccine clinic checklist below for motivational interviewing resources).
Strategy: Revisit patients who may have initially declined vaccination, missed
vaccination day in the dialysis clinic, or were admitted to the clinic after vaccination day.
Strategy: Attend a 1:1 coaching call with Network staff to assist with vaccination
challenges.
