Dialysis Facility Reports (DFRs) and Dialysis Facility Compare

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2744 Deadline and CMS Expectations

All transplant units must submit a complete CMS 2744 no later than Friday, April 14, 2023.

- All dialysis facilities & transplant units are to submit one 2744 every year.
 - The 2744 data is collected across the country and is then presented to the federal government & Congress. Accuracy is critical!
- All 2744s must be error free and all warnings must have a justifying comment from the facility.



Opening the 2744 in EQRS

- Start by going to the
 Facilities tab, then click on
 Form 2744.
- 2. Ensure the Survey Year shows as **2022**.
- 3. Change the Survey
- Status to Existing.
 4. Change the Search field to Facility, enter your CCN, and press Search.





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Opening the 2744 in EQRS, cont.

5. Next, click on View.

6. A new page will open, where you can edit and generate your 2744.

Generating the 2744

- 1. Click on Edit.
- 2. Click on Generate
- (it will take ~1-2 minutes).
- 3. Once generated, you



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can begin editing your 2744 fields*.

*Some fields are locked to editing. If changes are needed, you must change the patient record first, then regenerate the 2744, in order to capture needed changes.

4. Always click **Save**, when you're done.



Generating the 2744, cont.

PLEASE NOTE:

- All transplant unit's 2744s have been generated once by the Network already.
- Initially, you will see Alli's EQRS credentials: ALEXANDRA.BAILEY@DAVITA.COM
- Once you generate the 2744, your EQRS credentials will then show on the bottom of the 2744. This is required for a 2744 to be finalized.



Field 43

- Start by reviewing Field 43 for accuracy.
 - Field 43 is the number of transplants* performed at your unit in 2022.
 - *If a patient had more than one transplant in 2022, they will only count once on the 2744.
- Field 43 must equal Field 51.
 - If Field 43 is inaccurate, you must find the missing admission or discrepant patient record and make a correction to that record.

Fields 44 - 47

Fields 44 - 47 capture each patient's Medicare status as of 12/31/2022.

You should NOT need to change this data – it is static!

Fields 48 - 51

- Next review Fields 48 51 for accuracy.
- Use the End of Survey Transplant Report, compared to your organization's internal reports.
 - This report shows all reported transplants in EQRS from 01/01/2022-12/31/2022.

 If Fields 48 - 51 are inaccurate, you must find the discrepant patient record and make a correction to that record.

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Fields 43 & 51

- If Field 43 and Field 51 do not match, you must use the End of Survey Transplant Report
 Within the 2744.
- Using this report, check that all patients have a Citizenship status (column M) and a Medicare status (column P).
- If a patient's status is blank; then that patient does not have a Citizenship or 2022 Medicare status in EQRS, and one must be added. A blank status will cause a mismatch in Fields 43 & 51.

Field 51

- If Field 51 is **below** your expected transplant total for 2022, you are missing a patient admission in EQRS.
- If Field 51 is above your expected transplant total for 2022, you have an extra misattributed patient admission in EQRS.
 Please call Alli for reconciliation assistance.



Fields 52 & 53

- In Field 52, enter the total number of waitlisted patients on dialysis.
- In Field 53, enter the total number of waitlisted patients **NOT** on dialysis.
- These totals should be as of 12/31/2022.

Submitting & Printing the 2744

- Lastly, after you have verified all Fields are correct, any warnings have a comment, and any errors have been resolved; you will then click Submit for Review.
- The 2744 is then reviewed and finalized by the Network.
- You will receive an email notification if your 2744 was finalized or if additional attention is needed.



Warnings

- Your 2744 cannot be accepted without a comment for each warning (if applicable).
- You must add a justifying comment after you generate the 2744 and before you save & submit the 2744.



Errors

- All errors must be resolved before the Network can finalize your 2744 (if applicable).
- If you submit a 2744 with errors, it will be returned to you for further attention.
