MONTH ONE: OCTOBER Looking at your barriers.

- Review home dialysis facility reports (provided by the Network) to see how close you are to reaching your unit goals. Review your barriers for patients in choosing home dialysis - identify any common trends if any. Encourage MDs to refer patients to home dialysis. Discuss this at QAPI.
- Utilize resources in the <u>Home Dialysis Resource Toolkit</u> to identify an intervention for implementation to address gaps/opportunities identified in your root cause analysis.

- o Continue to build a **culture of home dialysis** within your unit. Start **self-cannulation** with those patients interested in home hemodialysis. Schedule PD catheter placements if interested in PD.
- Make a holiday bulletin board for the unit about the benefits of home dialysis for the holidays. We will have a
 contest for the most creative one. \$100 for the unit with the winner!! Reach out if you need additional resources.
- o Reach out to your home dialysis clinic to schedule a lobby day for patients to see and talk about home dialysis.

- Review and discuss any new admissions with your team. Identify potential candidates for home dialysis. Let me

 home unit does not get credit for those patients.
- Continue previous month activities evaluate trends and identify successful interventions or where new strategies are required.
