

Primary Diagnosis Categories

Although the Hospitalization project strategies support reduction of all-cause hospitalizations, readmissions, and emergency department visits, only those admissions and visits from the Primary Diagnosis Categories list (see below) are counted towards the rates. The data come directly from Medicare claims. Also please note, a readmission is counted towards the rate if it is from the Primary Diagnosis Categories AND has occurred within 30 days of discharge from the hospital following an admission from the Primary Diagnosis Categories.

Primary Diagnosis Categories

- A419 Sepsis, unspecified organism
- E875 Hyperkalemia
- E8770 Fluid overload unspecified
- I214 Non-ST elevation (NSTEMI) myocardial infarction
- I120 Hypertensive chronic kidney disease stage 5 or end stage renal disease
